14 ¶ <sup>a</sup>And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever.

26 And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then <sup>p</sup>he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.
